Group Day entries will not be accepted after this date, no exceptions. All Group Day entries must go through the Onewhero Ag Day Committee, NOT the Group Day host school (Pukekawa School).*

## ONEWHERO AG DAY CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries close Friday 21 September 2018, no exceptions.
- Entry is open to Onewhero ECC children and Onewhero Area School students in Years 1-8.
- Onewhero ECC children are permitted to enter a lamb or a goat.
- School-aged children are permitted to enter one animal (lamb, goat or Pet Parade animal) plus chickens.
- Children must be supervised by their parent/caregiver at all times.
- All animals must be on a lead (or caged) and under control at all times. Failure to do so puts the health and safety of others at risk and you may be asked to leave the school grounds.
- The Judges' decisions are final. Please respect them.
- Supporters are expected to be respectful of all Onewhero Ag Day participants and volunteers.
- Please be aware that Group Day animal categories may use different dates to our Ag Day.

### Dog Entries

- All dogs must be registered and fully vaccinated.
- You are responsible for removing and disposing of your dog's 'deposits'.
- All dogs must be on a lead and under control at all times. Failure to do so puts the health and safety of others at risk. If your dog causes a disturbance, you will be asked to remove your dog from the school grounds.
- Please ensure your child can safely handle the dog they are showing and that a responsible adult is ringside.
- Judges reserve the right to request an adult leads the dog with the child, using a separate leash.
- Adults are responsible for their dogs at all times.
- Dogs must remain in the restricted area, away from the other animals, or you will be asked to leave the school grounds.
- Dogs that are deemed to be 'Menacing by Breed' by The Dog Control Act 1996 are required to wear a muzzle and be on a lead and under control in public at all times. These breeds include *American Pit Bull Terrier, Brazilian Fila, Japanese Tosa, Dogo Argentino* and *Perro de Presa Canario*.  
In addition to this, the Waikato District Council also requires all *Pit Bull* and *Pit Bull X* dogs to wear a muzzle and be on a lead and under control in public at all times.

By entering your animal to participate in the Onewhero Ag Day 2018 you agree to abide by the Conditions of Entry outlined above.
