Group Day

Group Day will be held at Pukekawa School on Thursday 1 November. All students bringing a lamb, goat and/or a chicken to the Onewhero Ag Day can enter Group Day, regardless of their performance at Ag Day. Most students have indicated their intention to go to Group Day on their Ag Day entry form. If your child is *not* on the list and you would like them to go to Group Day, please email onewheroagday@gmail.com by the end of Thursday 25 October. Late entries will not be accepted.

Students who *are* going to Group Day should keep their Onewhero Ag Day tags for use at Group Day. Please return the tags to the Onewhero Area School office after Group Day, thank you.

Spud in the Bucket

All Spud in the Bucket entries should be returned to the school office on Friday 26 October, in the morning. The spuds are being judged on Friday afternoon.

Dads' Cake Competition

This year we are holding a Dads' Cake Competition and encourage the Dads in our school community to bake and decorate a cake. The cakes will be judged in the morning then auctioned before the Ag Day prizegiving, with all proceeds going towards the upkeep of the Junior and Middle School playgrounds.

Bring your masterpiece to the Food Tech room by 9.30am on Ag Day. The cakes will be judged on originality, creativity, and a 'sales pitch', which will be used in the auction of the cake. Entry form attached, or complete one on the day.

Since someone else may be taking your cake home, please make sure it's packaged for takeaway, e.g. a cake box or other sturdy box or container.

Ag Day Food & Refreshments

Food and refreshments will be available for purchase throughout the day – coffee, tea, cold drinks, ice-blocks, cakes and slices, hamburgers, ham buns and a sausage sizzle.

All funds raised will go towards the upkeep of the Junior and Middle School playgrounds.

You will find the food stalls in and around the Food Tech room near the bottom field. EFTPOS facilities will *not* be available. **Cash only.**

We ask that all Ag Day participants park on the top field (off Parsons Road) so children don't have to cross Hall Road with their animals. Please consider others when parking your vehicle.

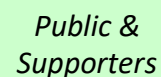
Restricted Area for Dogs

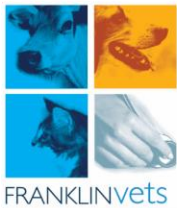
