### Principal's Message:

Tenā koutou kātoa,

Welcome back to the new term. The week has started well and all of the students and staff have come back energised and ready for a big term focused on learning!

Since our last newsletter we have had a number of exciting student successes. We have had nine students selected to represent the Pukekohe area in netball. A large number of our students were selected for Central North Island Area Schools sports teams and Tyler Brown, who placed 7th at a national motocross event in the 13-16 years age group. This is a great achievement as Tyler just turned 13 last month and was competing against much older and bigger riders.

Most significantly, as many of you will already be aware, Thomas Murray has become a double national champion in swimming. At the recent New Zealand age group championship, Thomas won gold in both the 50m and 100m backstroke. The 100m was won after qualifying for the final in sixth and having to race in an outside lane. In the 50m he also came from behind to win by the narrowest of margins. Well done, Thomas, the whole school community is proud of you!

It is now time to start thinking about Calf Club for 2018 and to make decisions about what animals you will be rearing. For those wishing to help out or be involved behind the scenes in making the day run successfully we will be holding a meeting in the Staffroom next Wednesday 9 May at 7pm. In the holidays nine student leaders went off to Akaroa for a week of intensive leadership training with students from other area schools around the country. Our school had the greatest representation at the camp. The student leaders have come back energised and full of good ideas for how they can show leadership around the school. We're looking forward to seeing them making positive changes to the school. Special thanks to Mr Burr for taking a week out of his holidays to accompany the students and an acknowledgement of Pub Charity and, in particular, McGinty's Turf and Sports Bar in Huntly for the grant that made it possible to send so many students to Christchurch.
